For discussion and reflection

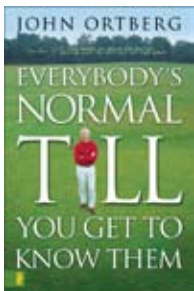

What are places in your life that you are refusing to submit? What are places in your life that you want to be more reflective of Jesus and less presented a certain way?

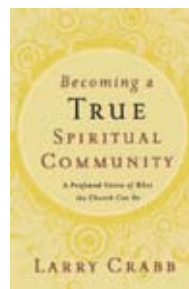
